Nine Patch  
Finished size: 6"

## MATERIALS

42"-wide fabric

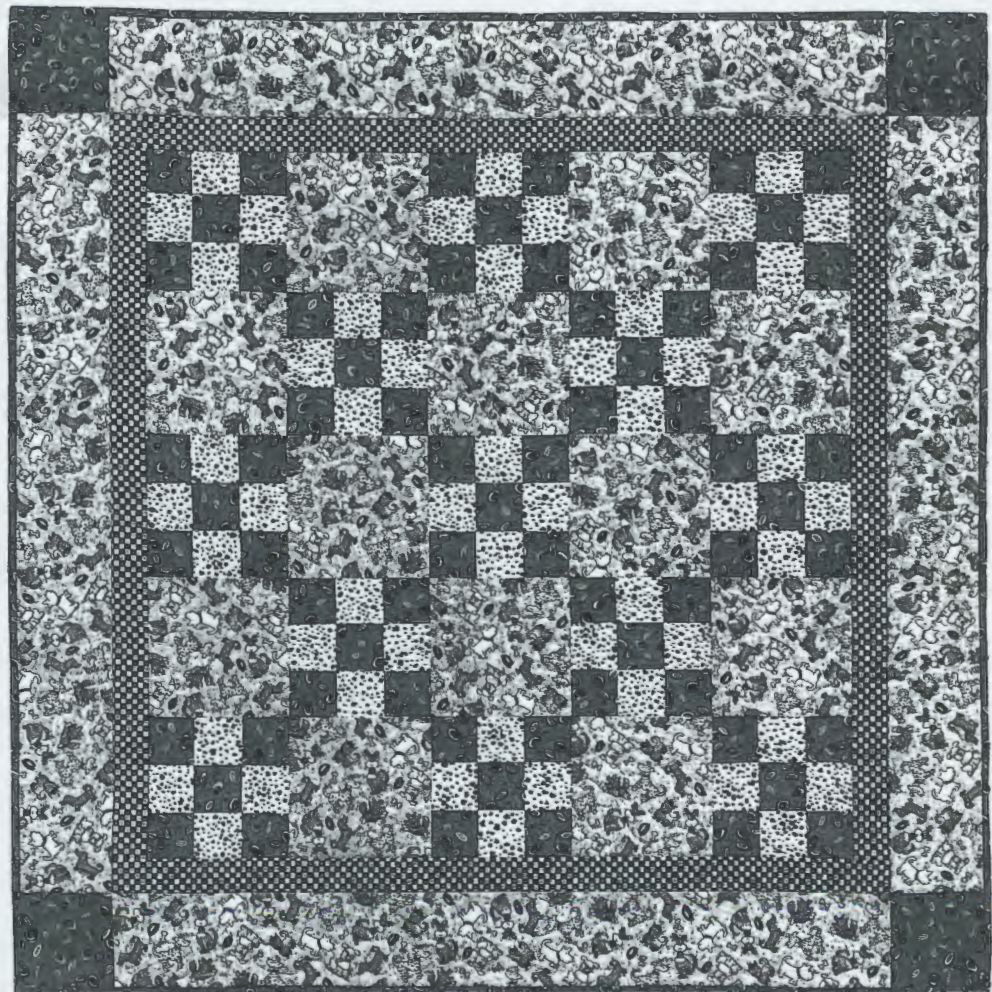
Fabric	Yardage
Theme print	1/2 yd.
Fabric A	1/2 yd.
Fabric B	3/8 yd.
Inner border (sides)	3/8 yd.
(top/bottom)	
Outer border	5/8 yd.
Corner squares	1/4 yd.
Backing	1 1/2 yds.*
Binding	3/8 yd.
Batting	44" x 44"

## CUTTING

Cut all strips across the fabric width

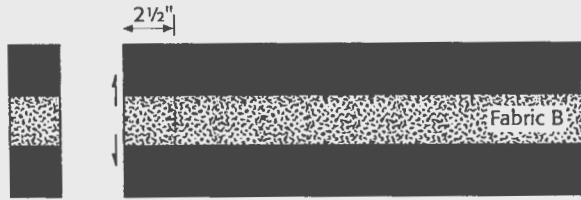

**DIRECTIONS**

1. Make 2 of Strip Set #1. Make 1 of Strip Set #2.  
From Strip Set #1, cut 26 segments, each 2½" wide. From Strip Set #2, cut 13 segments, each 2½" wide.

Cut 13.

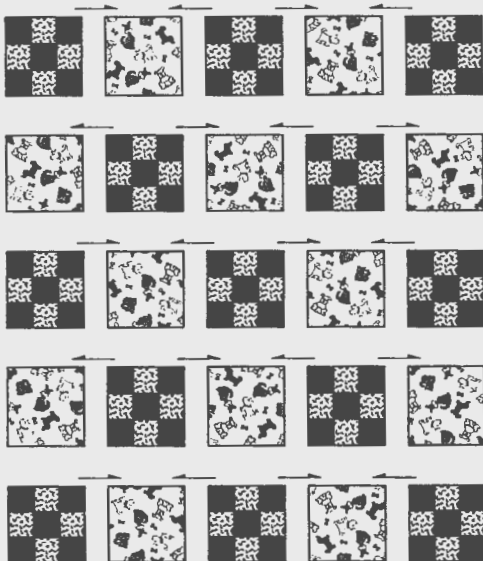
Strip Set #2

2. Make 13 Nine Patch blocks.

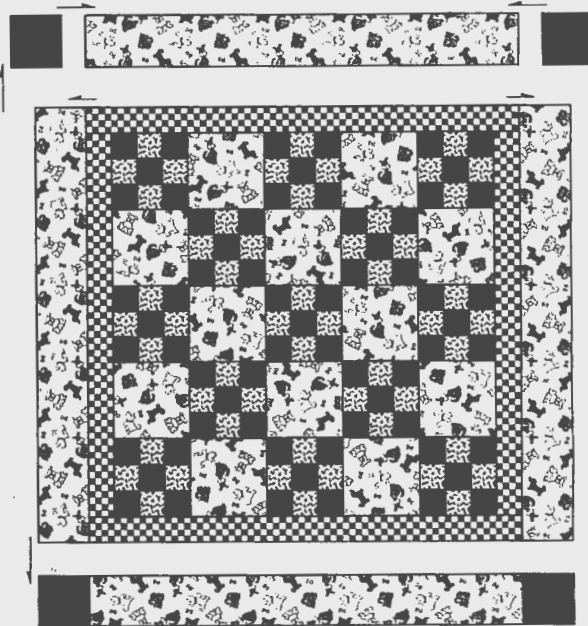


Make 13.

3. Arrange the blocks and squares in 5 rows.



4. Join the blocks in horizontal rows. Join the rows.
5. Sew the inner border strips to the side edges of the quilt top first, then to the top and bottom edges. See "Borders with Straight-Cut Corners" on page 11.
6. Sew the outer border strips to the sides first. Add a corner square to each end of the remaining outer border strips and attach them to the top and bottom edges. See "Borders with Corner Squares" on page 12.



7. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
8. Bind the edges and add a label.
